The legend of Gelert the Dog
 The gardens here at Plas Brondanw, the home of Clough Williams-Ellis, who built the Italianate village of Portmeirion, are considered to be his most important creation. Sir Clough created a unique and distinctive landscape inspired by the gardens of Renaissance Italy, providing a series of romantic views over the surrounding countryside, leading the eye to the dramatic backdrop of the mountains beyond.

 The Snowdon Mountain Railway gets you from Llanberis to the top of Snowdon for spectacular views, and the Llanberis Lake Railway skirts alongside Lake Padarn.

 A pair of magnificent ospreys can be seen close to the Pont Croesor Visitor Centre from Spring until late summer. Knowledgeable volunteers will answer your questions and you can use telescopes for a close-up view of the nest.

take flight on a thrilling zipwire
 Fancy flying through the air like a bird? At Zip World Penrhyn Quarry you could try the fastest zip line in the world and the longest in Europe. Or just enjoy watching others zipping by from the Blouin Restaurant, and take the Penrhyn Quarry Tour on a red truck.
 Zip World Forest has the UK's only alpine coaster where you can speed through the trees for over a kilometre - great fun, whatever the weather, and it also has Europe's longest net walkway and highest giant swing.

 With such glorious mountain scenery all around and views that take your breath away, Eryri is a great place to get out in the fresh air and enjoy walking. There is a network of walks for people of all abilities, from gentle lakeside strolls to the more energetic climbs that take you up to the top of Yr Wyddfa itself or one of the other many peaks in the range.

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
